**MAYOR'S REPORT:**

1. Advised that City Administrative offices have been relocated to the Public Safety Building located at 3909 Walnut Street due to damages from Hurricane Florence.
2. Prayer Breakfast will be held at Loris Elementary School on Tuesday, October 9, 2018 at 7:00 A.M.
3. Ms. Jen Boyd with the Loris Chamber of Commerce thanked Jordan Waste for picking up waste throughout areas of the City that flooded or received damage. Announced that the Bog-Off is scheduled for Saturday, October 20, 2018.

**ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT:**

All departments are still in recovery mode from hurricane Florence.

**PUBLIC WORKS:**

1. Mr. Harrelson advised the insurance adjuster has been met with and most items have been removed from City Hall to prevent any further damage. The portion of the building that caved in has been completely isolated.
2. Advised that repair on the two damaged sewer lines will be started within the next week.
3. Advised that a lot of leaf and limb has been picked up and bulk items will also be picked up in the upcoming weeks until all debris is removed.
4. Advised that the water study throughout the City began this week.

**RECREATION DEPARTMENT:**

1. Advised that the Recreation Department is lucky to have very minimal damage from hurricane Florence.
2. Thanked the City of Myrtle Beach for sending employees over to help after hurricane Florence.
3. Advised that all practices have resumed. Soccer coaches are still needed at this time.

ADJOURNMENT:




